

## **CORE MEMBER Eligibility and Suitability**

## ADAPTED CIRCLES FOR CORE MEMBERS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY

All referrals meeting the stated criteria will be considered, with priority given to those assessed as high or very high risk of serious harm and/or reconviction, in consultation with the local MAPPA Coordinator

## **Eligibility**

OFFENCE TYPE - SEXUAL	Current conviction and/or Mental Health Act treatment order for sexually harmful behaviour against adult or child (includes non-contact offences). Historic sexual offences/behaviour may also be considered if relevant risk and need criteria met.
INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY	Those with a diagnosis of intellectual disability (IQ under 80)
RISK CLASSIFICATION	OASys (or ARMIDILO-S): Medium, high or very high risk of serious harm
OASys & RM2000	RM2000: All static risk classifications will be considered
GENDER	Any
AGE	18 years or over
ATTITUDES &	Acknowledges that s/he has committed sexually harmful behaviour
BELIEFS	
STATUS	Statutory supervision by NHS, Probation and/or Police (e.g. Registered Sex Offender).

**Note:** please discuss suitability with Circles South West before completing the referral form if there are significant issues relating to mental health, personality disorder, substance misuse etc.

MOTIVATION	Committed to creating no more victims and to reduce his/her sexually harmful

LEVEL OF	Prepared to engage with a Circle on a voluntary basis
