Job Purpose

The Training Coordinator will lead the development and delivery of Circles South West's training and consultancy offer in South West England, establishing the Charity as a respected provider of training and consultancy in our specialist field.

The primary purpose of this service is to enhance the skills, knowledge and understanding of professionals, organisations and local communities, enabling them to effectively engage with people who have sexually offended and/or with harmful sexual behaviour, and contributing more widely to the prevention of sexual abuse.

The Training Coordinator will identify market demand; define our training and consultancy offer; produce a delivery plan; create content; design materials; negotiate contracts; lead on delivery; and evaluate the impact of this initiative.

This new initiative is an important part of our sustainability strategy. Income generated through the delivery of training and consultancy will be reinvested into our core work providing Circles of Support and Accountability.

It is anticipated that this post will be self-sustaining by 2022.

Flexible working is a requirement of this post which will involve:

- regular weekend work
- occasional evening work
- extensive travel across South West England, including regular overnight stays, to accommodate training delivery.

Main Duties

- To identify training and consultancy needs of a cross section of partner organisations and community groups that align with the Charity's USP (unique selling point)
- To design training package framework, content and materials
- To test out new training courses, making adaptations and improvements based on evaluation
- To co-deliver training courses with colleagues across the region
- To collate and analyse training evaluation, adapting and improving content and delivery accordingly
- To promote awareness of the Charity's training and consultancy offer across the region
- To secure training and consultancy contracts
- To design consultancy support on a bespoke basis in response to need, liaising with local coordinators to facilitate delivery
- To consistently evaluate training and consultancy support delivered
- To lead on other service developments in line with our USP as opportunities arise and as required
- To work closely with the CEO and other team members to achieve operational targets
- To work with the Volunteer Coordinator to facilitate Volunteer training

In common with other Circles South West staff the post-holder will be required:

- To co-deliver the volunteer training programme
- To collate appropriate and timely monitoring information and contribute to evaluation
- To manage local resources and equipment
- To actively partake in regular line-management supervision and annual appraisal
- To attend and contribute to team meetings
- To promote, monitor and maintain health, safety and security in the working environment
- To keep up to date with broad developments in work related issues
- To participate in the charity's outreach and educational work
- To prioritise safeguarding in all our work
- To attend coordinator forums and training events as organised by Circles UK.
