## Harmful sexual behaviour in the digital age; how best to understand, assess and work with problematic users. [Foundation]

This training day is of interest to professionals working with adults and young people with an online sexual conviction or internet based harmful sexual behaviour. It will enhance participants' knowledge and understanding of online pornography and the latest developments in technology around cybersex, and how this impacts on individuals' thoughts, feelings, behaviour and possible online offending.

It will explore on how people use the internet to view indecent images of children, 'groom' and offend against children on and offline and have contact with other like-minded individuals.

Trainers will discuss the latest research around the links between pornography and internet offending and the difference/similarities between contact sexual offending and internet only sexual offending. Delegates will have the opportunity to apply their learning to a case study.
