

WORKING WITH PEOPLE WHO HAVE SEXUALLY HARMED – A THEORETICAL & PRACTICAL TRAINING DAY [Foundation]



Thursday 5th August - Bournemouth

This 1 day training course will be of interest to professionals working with people who have sexually harmed, have convictions for sexual offending or are at risk of doing so.

The training will increase delegates' knowledge and understanding of theories around why people sexually harm, the prevalence of such behaviour, risk assessment and risk management. We will address issues around participants' own attitudes and beliefs and any associated 'blocks' to working with people who have sexually harmed. We will also provide a framework and worksheets for direct work that can be adapted for your individual and organisational need. We will cover the concept of 'masks' and working with resistance and finally, how participants can keep themselves emotionally and psychologically robust when working with sexual harm. Delegates will have the opportunity to apply their learning to a case study.

The training will include the following topics:

- Attitudes & beliefs – What do we/you/society think and feel about sexual offending/harmful sexual behaviour (HSB)
- What is sex offending/HSB: Definitions, prevalence and hierarchies
- Causes of sexual offending/HSB – internet and contact
- Risk assessment and risk management for those who sexually harm
- The Criminal Justice System and understanding the move to desistance theory and strength based approaches in working with people who sexually harm
- Creating a 'tool kit' for working with service users
- Masks – working with resistance, manipulation, minimisation and denial
- Impact of working in the field – maintaining boundaries and looking after yourself
